






Research Participant Portal

Offers stakeholders a unique entry point for the interactions with the European Commission or Agencies in handling grant related actions, based on:




Brings homogeneity, transparency and better service integration for grant management.














Services without login










- 1. Finding funding opportunities:
- Open / closed / forthcoming calls
- Latest information on published calls
- Search on the calls' pages (advanced search possibilities)






2. Access the electronic proposal submission system:

- Prepare & submit new proposals using EPSS OR the new proposal submission system of the Portal (available on the call page)
- The new proposal sub. sys. is a wizard that will help you create & submit a proposal, while ensuring data confidentiality. This tool is available from call launch to a strict deadline.


2. Access the electronic proposal submission system:

- PIC numbers are required, therefore the organisations need to register before drafting a proposal.
- You can save a draft proposal and submit it later.






2. Search specific FP7 documents

Search documents by title or through a full text search






- 1. Search for an existing PIC (Participant Identification Code) number

1. Register an organisation

- The person registering the data receives online the PIC number for his/her organisation.
- Participants are encouraged to register their organisations as soon as possible before drafting a proposal.





2. Access / Update organisation-related data - This is only available to the following roles:

- LEAR (Legal Entity Appointed Representative): person authorized to manage the legal data of the organisation online.
- Account Administrator(s): person(s) appointed by the LEAR to assist with the online management of the legal data. (...)





2. Access / Update organisation-related data - This is only available to the following roles:

- Self Registrant: person who has registered an organisation
- The contact person (given by the self registrant)






- 1. Access your proposals (draft or submitted) made with the new submission system

The majority of the calls have used the new submission system from July 2012










- 1. View all types of personal notifications for the linked services of the Portal

IAM

The major objective of the new version is to simplify the role management and make it more flexible.

In that perspective, the following updates took place:

- 1. The uniqueness of the Coordinator and Participant Contacts disappear:
- > one Primary Coordinator Contact as the main contact for the European Commission;
- more Coordinator Contacts can be nominated in the coordinating organisation per project;
- more Participant Contacts can be nominated per participating organisation per project.



IAM

- 2. Task Managers and Team Members are **no longer restricted to specific scope(s).**
- 3. The roles of Named Representatives are automatically redistributed:

Financial Named Representative → Coordinator/Participant Contact

Scientific Named Representative → Coordinator/Participant Contact

Authorised Representative → Coordinator/Participant Contact

Administrative/Legal Named Rep. → Task Manager

Authorised Signatory → Coordinator/Participant Contact

4. Those who register(ed) their organisation to obtain a PIC will have a **self-registrant role**.



FP7 / H2020 Documents:

- Transfer of the FP7 documents from CORDIS to the Participant Portal
- New search function (full-text search)

Organisation registration:

- New registration wizard (improved interface)
- Automatic search for duplicates in order to avoid unnecessary registrations
- Register an organisation on behalf of someone
- Manage multiple registrations

"My Proposals" tab:

- Access to the proposals submitted with the new tool

Detailed use of resources:

 The explanation on the use of resources has to be entered in financial reporting tool (more coherence, less risk of errors)



"My Roles" tab:

"Consortium" screen: possibility for the Coordinator
 Contacts and Participant Contacts to see the list of all the people in their consortium

All tables ("My Organisations", "My Roles", etc.):

- Improved user interface (action buttons)
- Possibility of printing and exporting tables in Excel





"FP7 Calls" tab:

- Search function (full-text search)
- Possibility to download all the documents in a .zip file related to a specific call
- Dynamic agenda of the calls (call publication dates, deadlines, call closure dates) compatible with most electronic agenda applications





Expert services:

• Migration of experts registration (EMI) from CORDIS to the Participant Portal – already took place!



Electronic-only signature of forms C:

 Transition from the paper version toward a full electronic management of forms C

Transfer from CORDIS of information related to participation:





A wizard to create the Proposal you want to submit! It includes:






