The objective is to develop and demonstrate -- at least at pilot scale -- technologies that will contribute effectively and on a large scale to remove greenhouse gases (GHG) from the atmosphere in a long-term perspective (over 100 years).¶

The technologies covered under this topic include biomass transformation into long-term carbon storage. Carbon Capture and Sequestration (CCS) technologies from fossil-fuel power and steam generation plants and biofuels production processes are not eligible under this topic. The overall objective shall be achieved avoiding any shift of burdens (in terms of environmental impacts, time and space or rebound effects). In order to assess that, the demonstration of the technologies shall be accompanied by Life Cycle Assessment studies carried out according to the International Reference Life Cycle Data System (ILCD) Handbook on LCA (<http://lca.jrc.ec.europa.eu/EPLCA/overview.htm>).¶

Funding scheme: Collaborative Project (small or medium-scale focused research project) (bottom-up topic area, up to 3 projects of maximum EC contribution of 2.5 M€)¶

Expected impact: Contribution to the achievement of EU 2020 and 2050 targets for GHG reduction.¶

Rules for participation

Minimum conditions for participation

At least **3** independent legal entities, each of which is established in a **MS** or **AC**, and no 2 of which are established in the same MS or AC

Minimum conditions for participation in the projects for specific cooperation actions (SICA) dedicated to international cooperation partner countries

At least **4** independent legal entities. Of these, **2** must be established in different **MS** or **AC**. The other **2** must be established in different international cooperation partner countries (**ICPC**)

Who can participate?

- **Any undertaking, university or research centre or other legal entity, whether established in a Member State (MS) or Associated Country (AC)* or third country**
- **JRC (Joint Research Centre) - is deemed to be established in another MS or AC**
- **International organisations and participants from third countries** can participate only if in addition to minimum consortium requirement
- Participants from **high-income countries**** are normally not eligible for EC funding

If you have a project idea and you would like to be the coordinator

- Analyse the needs of your project: **Try to find the BEST partners**
- Your partner should
 - be eligible
 - answer the needs of your project
 - have complementary skills
 - produce an added value for the project
- Where and how can you find the best partner?
 - Screen you own existing international contacts
 - Use the network of national contact points
 - Publish or disseminate your partner search
 - Attend information days, brokerage events, conferences ...

If you have a project idea but you do not want to be the coordinator

Define clearly your project idea and **try to find the MOST EXPERIENCED coordinator & consortium**

- Again check the eligibility criteria (type of the institution, geography...)
- Screen the former coordinators
- Screen your own existing international contacts
- Use the network of national contact points
- Attend information days, brokerage events, conferences ...
- Screen best practices

If you do not have an idea but you would like to be a beneficiary

- **Describe yourself : MOTIVATION LETTER**
 - Check if you are eligible for the call
 - Try to find the coordinators, call your friends & colleagues
 - Define your potential contributions to the project and the consortium
 - Screen the existing projects
- **and again...**
 - Screen you own existing international contacts
 - Use the network of national contact points (partner profile tools)
 - Publish your profile

Characteristics of a good consortium:

- Experienced coordinator and beneficiaries
- Complementarity
- Balanced geographical spread
- Senior scientists with track record
- Relevant experience /expertise
- Good infrastructure
- Longer cooperation foreseen within core consortium
- Multi-disciplinary
- Multi-sectoral (Academia-Industry)
- Enough human resource capacity in the coordinator and the beneficiaries
- Being attractive (attractive conditions for researchers)

OR

- **Work package leader**
- **Task leader**
- **Partner/associated partner**

COORDINATOR

- ✓ Represent the beneficiaries towards the EC
- ✓ Acts as intermediary for any communication between the EC and the beneficiaries

3. The *coordinator* shall:

- a) administer the *Community financial contribution* regarding its allocation between *beneficiaries* and activities, in accordance with this *grant agreement* and the decisions taken by the *consortium*. The *coordinator* shall ensure that all the appropriate payments are made to the other *beneficiaries* without unjustified delay;
- b) keep the records and financial accounts making it possible to determine at any time what portion of the *Community financial contribution* has been paid to each *beneficiary* for the purposes of the *project*;
- c) inform the *Commission* of the distribution of the *Community financial contribution* and the date of transfers to the *beneficiaries*, when required by this *grant agreement* or by the *Commission*;
- d) review the reports to verify consistency with the *project* tasks before transmitting them to the *Commission*;
- e) monitor the compliance by *beneficiaries* with their obligations under this *grant agreement*.

CONTRACTUAL OBLIGATIONS (art.II.2.3 GA) = no possibility of subcontracting

BENEFICIARIES

4. *Beneficiaries* shall fulfil the following obligations as a *consortium*:
- a) provide all detailed data requested by the *Commission* for the purposes of the proper administration of this *project*;
 - b) carry out the *project* jointly and severally vis-à-vis the *Community*, taking all necessary and reasonable measures to ensure that the *project* is carried out in accordance with the terms and conditions of this *grant agreement*.
 - c) make appropriate internal arrangements consistent with the provisions of this *grant agreement* to ensure the efficient implementation of the *project*. When provided for in Article 1.4 these internal arrangements shall take the form of a written *consortium agreement* (the "*consortium agreement*"). The *consortium agreement* governs *inter alia* the following:
 - i. the internal organisation of the *consortium* including the decision making procedures;
 - ii. **rules on *dissemination* and *use*, and *access rights***;
 - iii. the distribution of the *Community financial contribution*;
 - iv. **the settlement of internal disputes, including cases of abuse of power**;
 - v. liability, indemnification and confidentiality arrangements between the *beneficiaries*.
 - d) engage, whenever appropriate, with actors beyond the research community and with the public in order to foster dialogue and debate on the research agenda, on research results and on related scientific issues with policy makers and civil society; create synergies with education at all levels and conduct activities promoting the socioeconomic impact of the research.
 - e) allow the *Commission* to take part in meetings concerning the *project*.

Obligations of the beneficiaries as a Consortium (art.II.2.4 GA)

- **Partner Search** - Researchers or consortia with a definite idea for a project who are looking for further partners to complement the expertise scope of the consortium

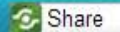

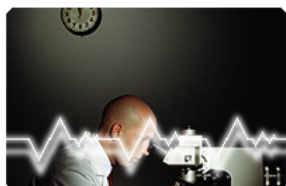

What is ETIS?

ETIS is the Estonian Research Information System. The Estonian Research Information System concentrates information on research- and development institutions, researchers, research projects and various research results. The Estonian Research Information System is also an information channel for submitting and processing grant applications and for submitting and confirming project reports.

For whom is the Estonian Research Information System?














The Estonian Research Information System is an information channel and a tool for researchers as well as R&D institutions. Researchers can use the Estonian Research Information System as a place, where they can submit applications for grant competitions, read news and chat in the forum about research. R&D institutions can submit through the Estonian Research Information System applications and introduce their research results more widely. Several R&D institutions use ETIS also as their internal research information system. Research funding organisations use ETIS for evaluating and processing applications and giving feedback.

What is the Estonian Research Portal?

Estonian Research Portal is the public section of the Estonian Research Information System. Estonian Research Portal concentrates information on Estonian R&D and offers an environment for operative information exchange. Research Portal gives an overview on various aspects of Estonian R&D. the Research Portal is also a channel for latest research news and where upcoming events have been gathered. The forum of the portal offers a possibility for expressing opinion on research related topics and discussing issues with other portal users.

Who has established the Estonian Research Information System?

The Estonian Research Information System has been established by the Estonian Ministry of Education and Research in cooperation with the Estonian Science Foundation, Scientific Competence Council, public universities, R&D institutions, R&D funding institutions and the Archimedes Foundation.
