

- Help MS reach european strategy objectives
   (Europe 2020, ET 2020, European Youth Strategy, Bologna & Copenhagen Process)
- New Context (Febr 2013: 5,7M unemployed young people →→ >2M vacancies)
- Budget increase by 40% to 14,7 billion €
   Croatia 2014: 13 million €
- SINGLE programme & Stronger EU added value and impact

## 3 Key Actions + Sport + Jean Monnet

#### Key Action 1: Learning mobility of individuals

- Staff mobility, in particular for teachers, lecturers, school leaders and youth workers
- Mobility for higher education students, vocational education and training students
- Student loan guarantee
- Joint Master degrees
- Mobility for higher education for EU and non-EU beneficiaries
- Volunteering and youth exchanges

#### Key Action 2: Cooperation for innovation and exchange of good practices

- Strategic partnerships between education/training or youth organisations and other relevant actors
- ⇒ IT-Platforms including e-Twinning
- Cooperation with third countries and focus on neighbourhood countries

# Same beneficiaries, stronger link with the world of work

- facilitate participation of those with special needs and from disadvantaged backgrounds + more support for teachers, trainers, information officers and youth workers
- Knowledge Alliances
- Sector Skills Alliances
- Strategic partnership projects: more focus on modernisation of institutions
- Schools and adult education: boost mobility of teachers & trainers and foster closer cross-border cooperation between organisations





### Simplification for beneficiaries

- user friendly e-forms grant applications and beneficiary reports
- "simplified grants" extended to all decentralised actions
- integrated IT tools to facilitate NA administrative processes
- address skills gaps partly by enabling > 4 million people, most of them young, to learn or gain experience abroad
- > 125,000 organisations and institutions will have the opportunity to develop partnerships





## Some output figures

- more than 4 million people learning or gaining experience abroad
- 25 000 Strategic Partnerships, involving 125 000 institutions and organisations, to implement joint initiatives and promote exchange of experience and know-how and links with the world of work
- Nearly 300 Knowledge Alliances and Sector Skills Alliances, involving 3500 education institutions and enterprises working together
