Setting the context

- Croatian Strategy for Education, Science and TechnologyTo increase mobility of students and staff,
- To increase number of joint programmes,
- European trends
- To remove obstacles to QA of joint degrees;
- To have a single QA procedure;

...to recognise QA decisions of EQAR-registered agencies on joint and double degree programmes.

External QA processes in Croatia (1)

Institutional level

- public universities;
- initial accredition of programmes by universities;
- reacreditaion of universities
 by the ASHE (QAA);
- accreditation of joint programmes by all HEIs in CRO awarding joint degree according to their internal procedures.

Programme level

- professional HEIs, private universities;
 - accreditation of institutions and programmes by the ASHE (QAA).

To be regulated:

- accreditation of joint programmes;
- recognition of accreditaion decission of a foreign HEI or a



Accreditation models

When all HEIs have selfaccrediting power:

joint accreditation procedure
 of HEIs awarding joint
 degree;

separate accreditation
 process in each country;

 single accreditation procedure recognised by all cooperating HEIs. When HEIs are subject to programme level external QA:

 single accreditation procedure by one EQAR-registered agency that includes all HEIs involved in awarding of joint degrees;

Recognition of accreditation decisions;





External QA processes in Croatia (2)

- Precondition for delivery of joint programmes all HEIs involved accredited according to the ESG or equivalent;
- Implementation of joint programmes based on cooperation agreement between HEIs;
- Joint programmes does not equal to delivery of a foreign study programme.
- Demanding procedure (MoSES Register of HEIs, Register of public service institutions by the Commercial court, accredited by the Croatian accreditation authority) and vague (according to the procedures prescribed by the minsiter to be regulated).



Perspective for Development of Joint Degrees in Croatia

- To encourage partnerships in design and delivery of joint programmes and awarding of joint degrees;
- To develop joint programmes in the fields of expertise;
- To develop internal procedures for accreditation (universities)
- To develop legal provisions to allow for proffessional HEIs to deliver joint programmes and award joint degrees (ministry);
- To assure sustainibility of joint programmes with a view for students to complete their studies;
- For the HEIs to fulfill criteria and preconditions to apply for Erasmus + funds;
