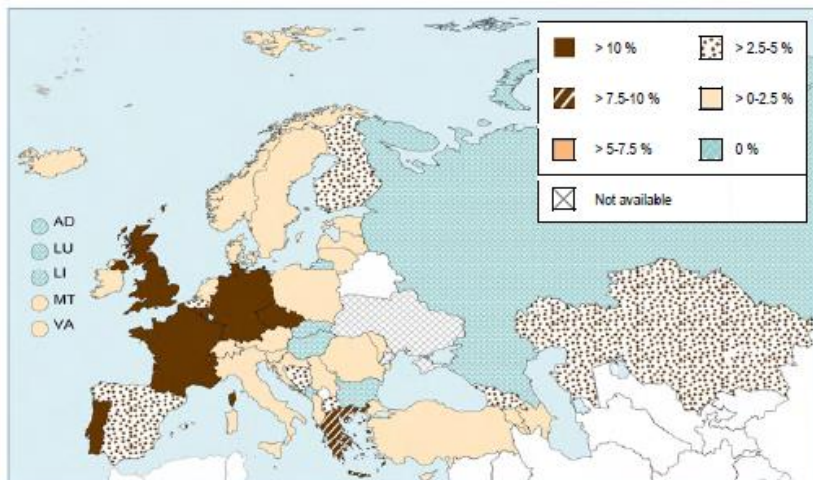
Joint programmes in EHEA

- Instrumental for EHEA development
- Erasmus Mundus joint programmes (check out the list of Courses)
- **Joint degree:** a single document awarded by HEIs offering the joint programme and nationally acknowledged as the recognised award of the joint programme
- **Joint programme**= integrated curriculum coordinated and offered jointly by a consortium of two or more HEIs and leading to double or multiple degrees.

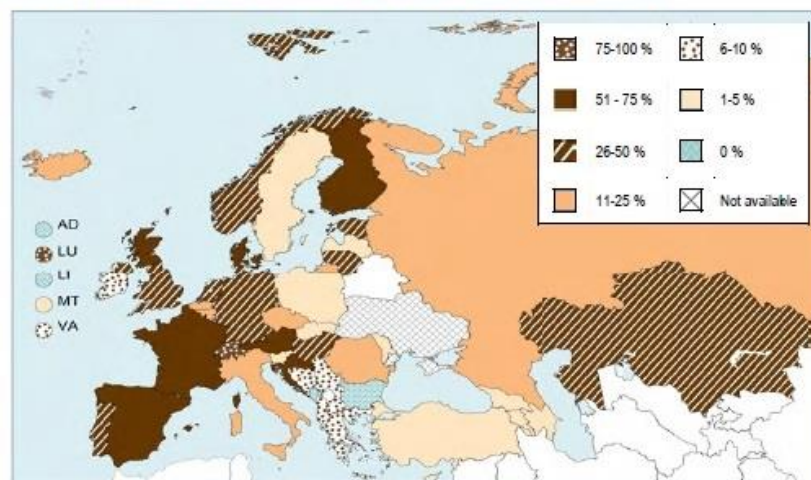
awarding joint degrees vs. participation in joint programmes

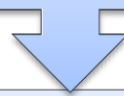
Bologna implementation report

- Belgium (FR), Czech Republic, France, Germany, Portugal, UK have more than 10% of their HEIs issuing joint degrees
- In majority of countries under 2.5% of HEIs award joint degrees
- Only Albania, Finland, Germany, Italy, Lithuania, Luxemburg, Norway, Romania and Spain provide additional funding to HEI for development and implementation of joint/double degree programmes
