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Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees

... ex Erasmus Mundus Master Courses

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EMJMD:

- is a high-quality curriculum selected by the EC /EACEA
- for excellent students from the whole world
- includes mandatory study period in at least two Programme Countries
- leads to the award of fully recognised Joint / Multiple Degrees

Consortium:

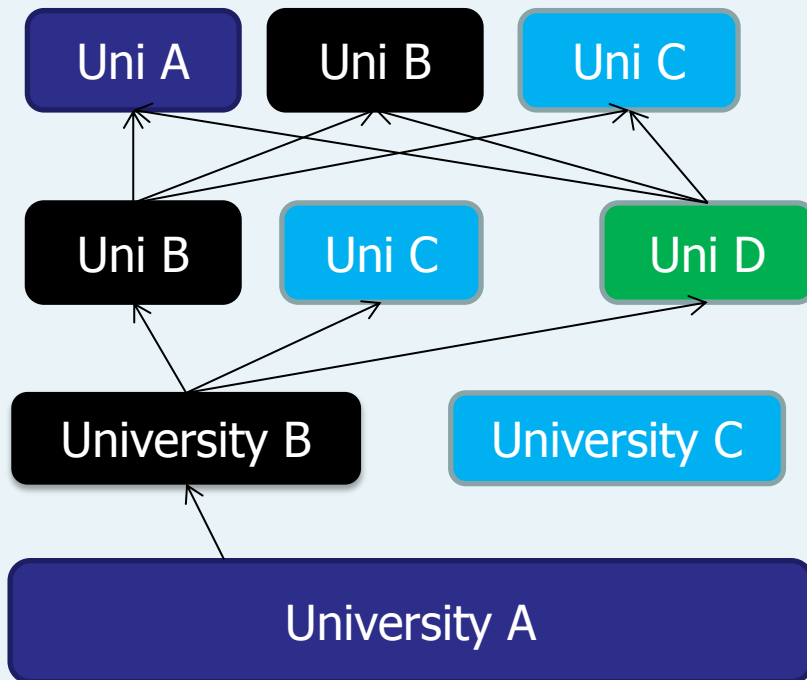
- Programme Countries: EU28 and EEA (FL, IS, NO), MK, TR
- At least 3 HEIs from at least 3 different Programme Countries
- May also include HEI from Partner Countries and non-academic partners

EMJMD Curriculum

- Curriculum has to be integrated in all aspects
- 1 to 2 years Master Course (60 /90 / 120 ECTS)
- Fully developed at the time of application and ready for 3 consecutive editions as from 2016/17 (**new**) or 2017/18
- Fully recognised EMJMD by first students' enrolment
- Fully recognised double, multiple or joint degree
- Obligatory study period in at least 2 programme countries:
 - at least 20 ECTS (1 year) / 30 ECTS (up to 2 years)
 - for students from Programme Countries different from country obtained the last HEI degree
- Mobility to Partner Countries possible if HEI foreseen
- Internships and placements possible

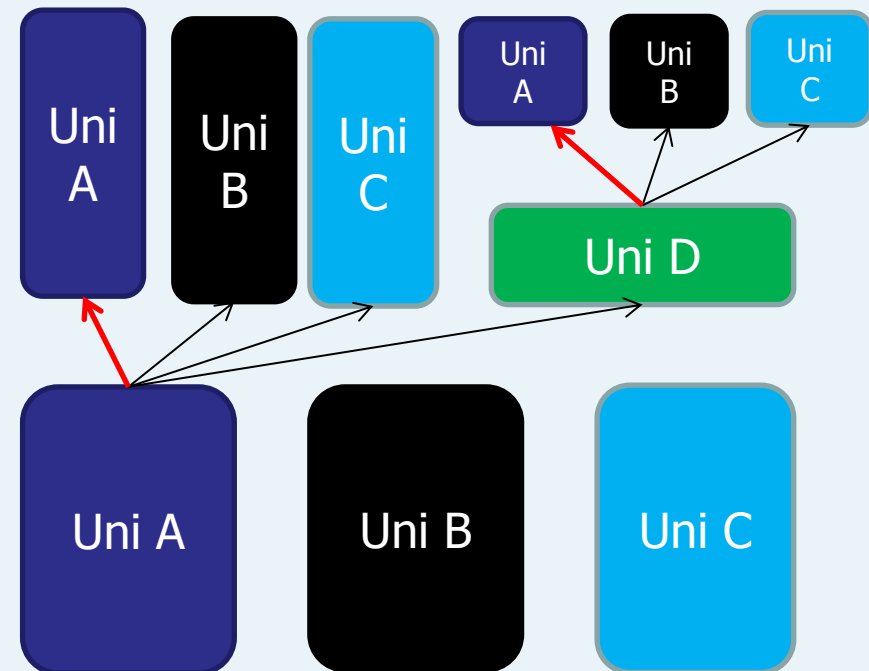
EMJMD Curriculum - Examples

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- Insurance coverage to students
- Support students in obtaining visa, residence permits, housing, perhaps schools for their children
- During their stay: offer tutoring / buddy system
- Student agreements on rights and obligations
- Students participation costs: difference between students from Programme Countries and Partner Countries possible
- Students join immediately the Erasmus+ Student and Alumni Association

EMJMD Financial Support & Management

- Different levels of management boards, e.g.:
 - Academic Board
 - Administrative Board
 - Students' Board
 - Selection Board
 - Quality Assurance Board
- Management of the consortium and the implementation of the EMJMD for 3 consecutive intakes:
 - Fixed total budget for the 3 intakes
 - between 13-20 scholarships per intake → 39-60 per grant agreement
- Supporting the costs of invited scholars / guest lecturers contributing to the delivery and the excellence of the EMJMD
- High level students scholarships awarded to the best master students worldwide

EMJMD Grant

- € 20.000,- for the preparatory year (optional) + € 50.000,- per intake

Contribution to participation costs	up to € 9.000,- per year	up to € 4.500,- per year
Contribution to travel costs	€ 2.000 per year (< 4.000 km) € 3.000 per year (> 4.000 km)	€ 1.000 per year
Contribution to installation costs	€ 1.000,-	---
Living allowance (max. 24 months)	€ 1.000 per month	€ 1.000 per month

Award Criteria (2015 Call)

- Projects will be assessed against the following criteria:
 - Relevance of the project (max 30 points)
 - Quality of the project design and implementation (max 25 points)
 - Quality of the project team & the cooperation arrangements (max 20 pts)
 - Impact and dissemination (max 25 points)

- To be considered for funding, proposals must score **at least 70 points** overall
&
- **1st step: 75%** (22,5 points) of the maximum allocated points for "relevance"
- **2nd step: 60%** of the max. allocated points for each of the remaining criteria

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
