BASIC REQUIREMENTS:

Croatian citizenship

Evidence of employment in the Republic of Croatia

Five years of professional experience

University degree (4-year undergraduate degree is required)

Proficiency in English

APPLICATION PROCEDURE AND COMPETITION SCHEDULE

The competition and on-line applications are open from April 14 through May 10, 2014. All applications, including references, undergo technical and academic reviews. Candidates who satisfy all requirements will be interviewed by Croatian-American interviewing teams in June 2014. Personal interviews are obligatory. Skype or phone interview will not be available. Based on interview results, the list of finalists will be submitted for final approval to the J. William Fulbright Board of Foreign Scholarships in the United States. Selected grantees will be notified of the final approval in March 2015. For the most part, the programs will start in mid-August of 2015.

Finalists for Humphrey awards will be required to take a Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL).

RECRUITMENT: Appropriate candidates are mid-career professionals in leadership positions who have the required experience/skills, commitment to public service and potential for advancement in their professions. Prospective fellows should have a minimum of five years professional experience and should be policy rather than research or technically oriented.

NOT ELIGIBLE: Recent university graduates, university teachers with no management responsibilities (except in the field of TOEFL), and individuals with recent U.S. or third country experience (more than 6 months during the 7 years prior to August 2014), individuals with dual U.S. citizenship or U.S. permanent residence status, individuals who have attended a graduate school in the U.S. for one academic year or more during the seven years prior to August 2015, and individuals who have previously participated in U.S. Government sponsored programs (Humphrey, Fulbright, Ron Brown, JFDP).

Additional documents which must be mailed (post-marked) by registered mail **by May 10, 2014** include:

- xerox copy of "domovnica" (in Croatian)
- xerox copy of university degree (in Croatian)
- letter from employer confirming employment in Croatia (in English or Croatian)
