The Saxon State Ministry of Education, Cultural Affairs and Sports in Dresden (Germany) in cooperation with the German National Agency PAD is very pleased to invite you to a COMENIUS contact seminar "Schools on the move" from 6-9 October 2011 in Dresden/Germany.

Theme: The focus will be on promoting new COMENIUS schoolpartnerships. The title of the seminar echoes the Commission's new initiative "Youth on the move" and addresses all schools which are eager to develop fresh ideas to improve teaching and learning by working together with European partners. There is no restriction on the subject matter of the proposed partnerships – the only prerequisite is the wish to "get on the move".

Target group: Headteachers and teachers from secondary and vocational schools (age of pupils: 10 – 18 years)

Languages: English/some knowledge of German will be helpful

The seminar fee (for accommodation, meals and cultural events) will be 550 EURO. All nominated participants will receive an invoice and are kindly asked to pay the contact seminar fee before the seminar start to the German National Agency PAD.

There are 50 places available. We would be glad to welcome 4-5 participants from each country + 1 NA representative. Please let us know **by 1st July 2011** how many places you would like to reserve and please try to keep the number of participants you announce. Deadline for the registration forms will be **1st September 2011**.
