Working language:

The working language of the seminar will be English.

Registration:

A total number of 80 participants are envisaged, 65 places will be reserved for LLP school representatives from abroad and 15 from Hungary. The places will be filled on first come, first-served basis, in case of exceeding the planned number, we

reserve the right to select among the applicants and put some registered representatives on a reserve list. (max. 4 representatives / country are accepted; 1 representative/institution would be appreciated).

Deadline for registration will be 5th October 2012 12:00 a.m., or as soon as the maximum number of participants has been reached.

Costs:

The participation fee is 382 € which includes accommodation, meals and cultural events. Each confirmed participant will receive two proforma invoices/documents via e-mail covering two parts of the total fee (original invoices will be passed during the seminar). Deadline for payment of both invoices is 29th October 2012. Organisers will send more information on invoicing and payment to the

confirmed participants via e-mail after closing the registration.
