<p><u>Costs</u></p>	<p>Those interested in participation should apply for a “Comenius Preparatory Visit” grant at their National Agency. This grant covers travel and participation costs. Only participants with such a grant will be accepted. We only allow one person per school to participate in the seminar.</p> <p>The seminar fee for accommodation and meals will be 480 euro. The participants will receive an invoice and are requested to pay the contact seminar fee before the start of the seminar to the organising National Agency, EPOS vzw.</p> <p>Due to the limited number of single rooms in <i>Landcommanderij Alden Biesen</i>, participants may be asked to share a room.</p>
