Participants will not only learn how to read information encoded on a potsherd, but be able to apply their knowledge to a context of material from an archaeological site. The participants will therefore be directly involved in the process of ceramics analysis in the field. The way archaeological material will be interpreted makes this project new, original and innovative. Pottery is the primary carrier of every group's cultural identity. Each group created its own brand through their local pottery characteristics. This phenomenon served as a means of invisible globalization. The ceramic material is not a purpose in itself, but rather a means to show its function as a tool of invisible globalization. Various societal changes can be traced on potsherds. A merging of traditional and new elements, on a local and global scale, is visible from these cultural encounters. The aim of this research project is to determine how pottery, used primarily in everyday tasks and purposes, also functioned as a means of spiritual colonization that spread across political and administrative boundaries.
